Buffer
also known as
Floor Machines



Used for stripping,
buffing and cleaning

Burnisher
also known as
High Speed Burnisher



Used for Ultra High Speed
Burnishing

Motor sits in CENTER of unit

process is being done

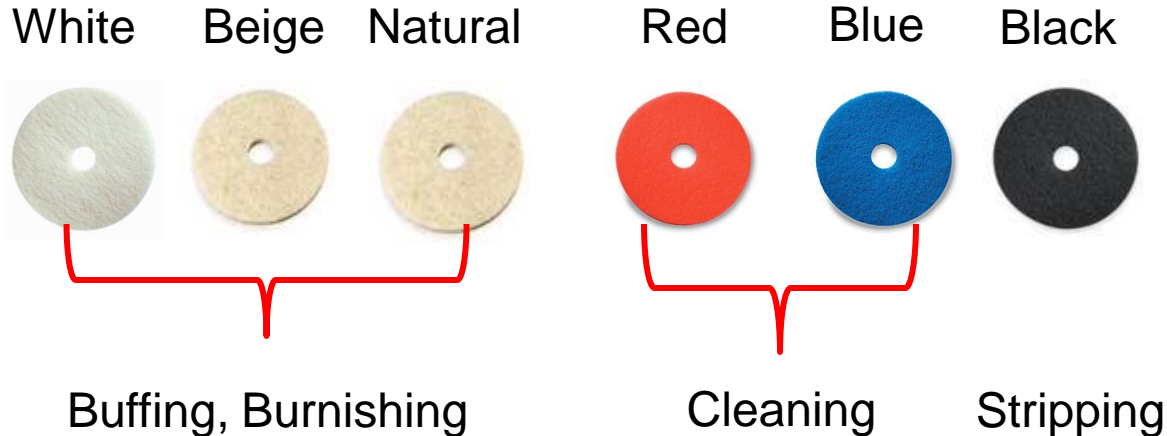

Pad Colors and Uses

The darker the pad color, the more aggressive the pad

the ground



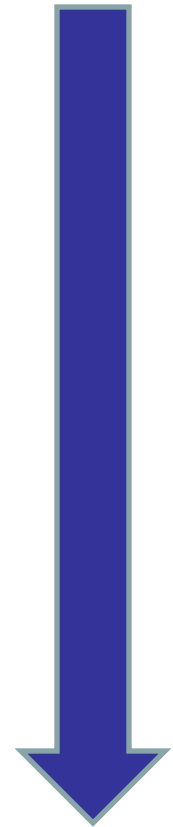
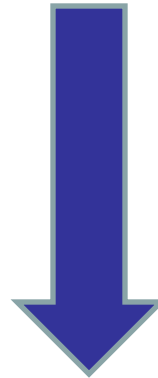
Motor is NOT
centered
on unit, it sits
closer to the
handle

When being used
unit is run in
straight lines over
the floor

Burnishers

Use:

- UHS
(Ultra High Speed)
Burnishing*

*Gives floors a deep
"WET LOOK" shine





EQUIPMENT & SERVICE
DIVISION

Buffers vs. Burnishers

Buffers

- Low speed
- Never use on DRY floor
- Pad color determines use
- Motor sits in center of unit
- Wheel do NOT touch ground when in use
- Works in an “arch” pattern
- Stripping, Buffing, Cleaning

Burnishers

- High speed
- Never use on a WET floor
- Uses lighter color pads
- Motor is offset on unit
- Wheels ALWAYS touch ground when in use
- Works in a “straight line” pattern
- Burnishing (Wet Look)
